

COVID-19 VISITATION UPDATE

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, Flagler Health+ has focused on ensuring the health, safety and well-being of patients, team members and area residents. With an emphasis on surrounding the community with care during this challenging time, every aspect of the enterprise has played a role in delivering clinical and supportive services.

Since April, Care Connect+, has served over 1,100 families in St. Johns and Flagler Counties impacted by COVID with resources such as rental and utility payment assistance, mental health and well-being support and access to food.

More than 16,000 people have been tested for COVID-19 at Flagler outpatient locations since July, including the drive-thru test site, emergency care center, laboratories and urgent care locations. Inside the hospital walls, our critical care team has helped hundreds of patients recover, delivering the highest level of care around the clock.

Currently, there is a small increase in the number of patients hospitalized at Flagler



with COVID-19, as compared to prior months. Daily volumes are ranging from approximately 15-20. These numbers are fluid, as new patients are diagnosed and others are discharged. These volumes are less than half of the census in July, with a peak of 44 hospitalized cases during that month. Flagler Hospital has a proven and scalable operations plan and is well prepared should a more significant surge occur to safely care for all patients in this dynamic environment.

Looking ahead, a team of physicians, pharmacists, infection prevention specialists

and others are collaborating to ensure that Flagler Health+ is prepared to store vaccines, support public health needs and also protect our team members.

It is important to know that the hospital is a safe place. People experiencing symptoms of heart attack, stroke or other medical emergencies should seek treatment immediately. Patients can be confident that Flagler has all the appropriate protocols in place to keep them safe and address their health concerns.

Flagler Health+ Care Connect was proud to host its first annual B.R.A.V.E. Summit this November. The B.R.A.V.E. program (Be Resilient and Voice Emotions) was generously funded by THE PLAYERS Championship in the fall of 2019 with a \$1 million donation.

Since then, the Flagler Health+ Care Connect staff have worked to address the growing behavioral health needs affecting students and families in St. Johns County public schools. The inaugural event allowed over 60 attendees to connect virtually and learn about the importance of mental health resources, especially during times of global crisis. Keynote speaker Ross Szabo, Wellness Director at the Geffen Academy at UCLA and award winning mental health speaker, covered important topics including mental health coping tools, identification of healthy relationships and the importance of addressing your emotions and feelings.
